


RESPONSIVE EYE








Action & Reaction


In reality, for every action you make, there always a reaction you get from people, either equal or opposite reaction (Approval or rejection).









Action and Reaction (1,3,4,6,7) Oil on canvas 40cm x 60cm 2020













Viscosity of Thoughts






















Delicate Balance 1 and 2 Oil on canvas 50cm x 70cm 2020


Strength in Unity Oil on canvas 106cm x 152cm 2020

The THERMAL EX-PANSIVITY theory gives more precise explanation in a brighter angle the AWELEWA SERIES.


